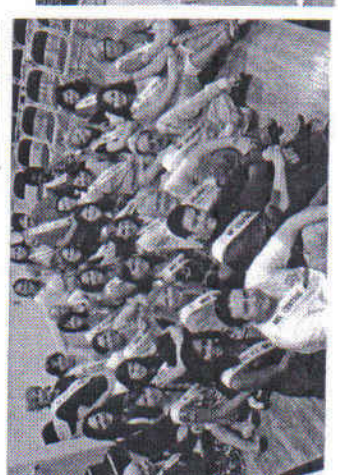
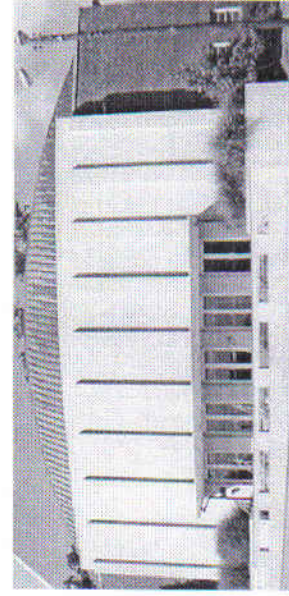

# America's Miss and Mr. U.S. National Pageant

## 7 Age Divisions • Women and Men

PLEASE CHECK CORRECT DIVISION

— **America's Miss Teen U.S.** - (Ages 13-17) Contestants should have never been married or given birth to a child.

— **America's Miss U.S.** - (Ages 18-29) Contestants should have never been married or given birth to a child.

— **America's Mrs. U.S.** - (Ages 18-Up Married) Contestants should be legally married and residing with spouse.

— **America's Ms. Elite U.S.** - (Ages 18-Up) Contestants may have been divorced, widowed or single with children.

— **America's Ms. Classic U.S.** - (Ages 18-Up) This division is for ladies size 14 or larger. Contestants may be single, divorced, married, widowed or single w/children.

— **America's Ms. Elegant U.S.** - (Ages 40 and Over) This division is for ladies 40 years old or older. Contestants may be single, married, divorced, widowed or single with children.

— **America's Mr. U.S.** - (Males 18-up) This division is for men ages 18-up. Contestants may be single or married.

*All divisions will compete in three categories to determine the winner of each age group: Formal Wear Competition (25%), Casual Wear Competition (25%) and Personal Interview Competition (50%). There will be side events for Photogenic, Best Formal Wear, and Congeniality winners. You are entered in these side events with your registration fee. There is not an extra charge. Side events winners will receive official America's U.S. glass plaques.*

Complete the Application Form and send to America's Miss and Mr. U.S. Pageant, 701 E. Georgetown Street, Crystal Springs, MS 39059, along one headshot photo. The entry fee for the national pageant is only \$150, plus a \$20 banner fee and a \$25 video fee for a grand total of \$195.00. Contestants will receive the official state contestants' packet after entry fee is paid. This packet will include your fact sheet to fill out for the judges, your auditorium and hotel information along with your schedule of events for the day. Check in time is 5 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Friday, June 15, 2012 at the Vicksburg City Auditorium. Rehearsals will be from 5 to 9 p.m. On Saturday, June 16, 2012 interviews will begin at 9 a.m. and then rehearsals will start back up at 1 p.m. The pageant will be at 6 p.m. All applications must be received no later than **MAY 25, 2012.**

You may pay your \$150 entry fee OR you may sell one full page (\$200) of advertisements in the program book to cover your entry fee. (you would still need to turn in your banner and video fee also for a total of \$245. A full page in the program book is \$200. You can sell full page sponsorships, 1/2, 1/3 or 1/4 page sponsorships, as long as it equals \$200 per page. All ad pages must be turned in no later than **MAY 25, 2012.** Please include one photo of yourself for each ad page turned in.

America's Miss and Mr. U.S. Pageant will be held on **JUNE 16, 2012** at the Vicksburg City Auditorium in historic Vicksburg, Mississippi. Details of the pageant schedule will be mailed individually to the contestants once application and registration fee are received. Contestants will be responsible for their hotel accommodations, food and travel expenses during the state pageant. Titles may only be reserved by sending in your entry fee. Contact the pageant office for hotel information. Tickets will be sold at the door for friends and family to watch. Admission prices are \$25 per person. Kids 10 and under will be \$10 each. *America's Miss and Mr. U.S. is one of the very few pageants in the United States that offers men the opportunity to compete for and win a national title.*

**At the national pageant, all contestants will compete in:**

**Formal Wear Competition:** Men will wear suits or tuxedos. Women will wear long formal gowns. We will provide music to walk to on stage. Formal Wear Competition is 25% of the total score.

**Casual Wear Competition:** This is your time to show your personality in a casual setting. Jeans, slacks, pantsuits . . . it's your choice. Just no formal wear please. Casual Wear Competition is 25% of the total score

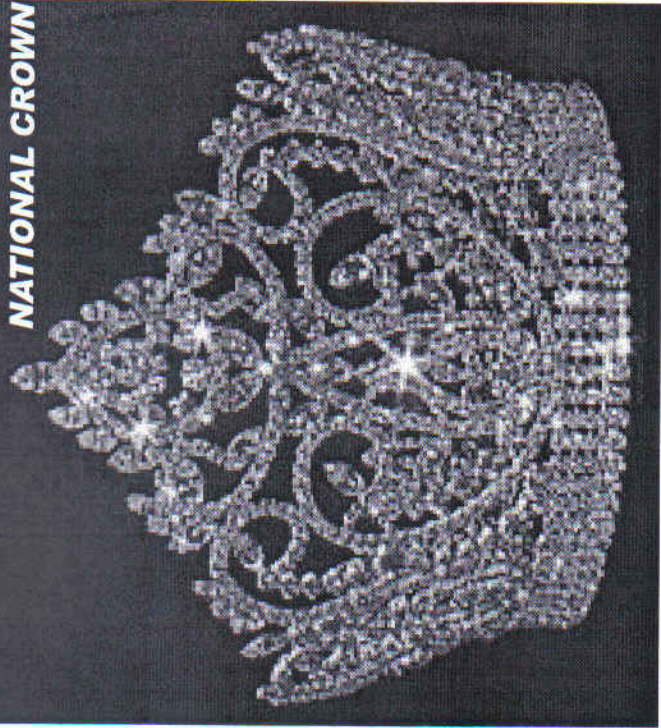
**Personal Interview with Judges:** Men are to wear slacks with dress shirts (with or without neck ties, with or without jacket) and women are to wear business suits (either jacket and skirt or jacket and pants or nice dress). Interviews will be panel style. Interview is 50% of the contestants' score. Contestants will stand for the interview behind a podium.

**Opening Number Outfit:** All contestants are to wear black pants. Men will need to wear black shoes and women black heels. Shirt colors are determined by your age division below. Shirts may be plain, glitzy, sequined, etc.

- Teens (13-17): Turquoise Blue Shirts • Miss (18-29): Yellow Shirts
- Ms. Elite (18-Up): Green Shirts • Mrs. (18-Up): Red Shirts
- Classic (size 14 and up): Royal (dark) blue Shirts
- Elegant (40 years and up): Purple Shirts
- Mr. (18-up): Black Long Sleeve Shirts
